VISITORS BUSINESS:

1. **Fence Viewer, Earl Bessette** – He doesn't feel that the issue at the River Park can be solved by having the Fence Viewers go and walk the property lines. Mr. Bessette suggested the Town have the Park re-surveyed. Discussion about what took place at the previous Selectboard meeting (see minutes from 9/15/09). Roger Boise and Pat Paquette will go and measure the lines for the River Park, find any existing pins and do the same for the neighbor's properties that abut the Park. Keith Hall said he look at the deeds for Menard, LaFlam and Moye. Barb Torian suggested having the Town lawyer look over the deeds as well, since there are dry wells involved. Pam Marsh is going to contact Town attorney Cindy Hill on the matter.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Keith Hall was approached by Beeman Elementary School's custodian in regards to him moving the dumpsters away from the edge of the school to the north of Town Hall. Discussed the best location to place them accommodating both the school, town offices and library; but also not to impede any plowing during the winter months.
