

**Town of New Haven Selectboard

Discuss the **different options for a new Health Care plan** for the Town. Currently the Town has Health Insurance through VLCT. Keith Hall contacted Blue Cross / Blue Shield to see what plans they have to offer. Pam Kingman said she was concerned about the Town leaving VLCT because of other incentives that go with being a PACIF member, and the Dental Insurance is through VLCT as well. Pam Kingman will look into the amount the Town pays for the Dental Insurance for the year and find out what the Town gives up if we choose to go with another health care provider. * **Update** – Dental Insurance for four employees currently cost the Town \$1,500 for the year. If the Town leaves Cigna Health insurance through VLCT, it means you opt out of things like health screenings, flu clinics, long and short term disability to name a few. * No action taken.

2. Keith Hall asked the Selectboard if they supported him approaching Linda Sleeper in regards to purchasing a piece of her property that borders the Towns property. Each member agreed with Keith Hall, he will talk to her.
