On Tuesday, April 2, 2024, beginning at 6:30 p.m., the New Haven Selectboard will hold a public hearing on amendments to the Town's Zoning and Subdivision Regulations, as submitted by the Planning Commission. PLEASE PLAN TO ATTEND!

The proposed updated and revised Zoning and Subdivision Regulations have been combined and redesigned to navigate and interpret more easily. These proposed Regulations include a step-by-step Introduction to the building application process; an Index, updated Zoning Map; a Zoning Districts Table showing density and dimensional standards applicable to land development in each of the Town's eight zoning districts; and a comprehensive Table of Allowed Uses that lists standards which apply to specified uses as allowed within one or more zoning districts.
