In the meantime, stop in at the library to see the new items on the shelves.

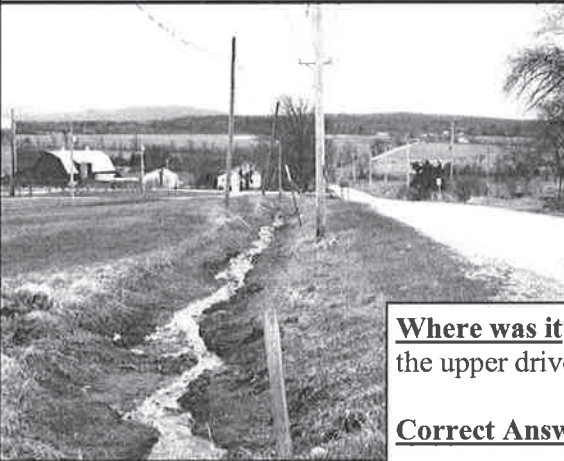
