School Board News

The New Haven School Directors convened for their regular monthly meeting on June 14th. There is no meeting scheduled in July. The Board reviewed projected fiscal year-end (June 30th) financial information. A budget surplus is expected for Beeman at a level comparable to last year. Budgeted encumbrances and plans for building maintenance and equipment purchases were reviewed and confirmed. The Board also heard favorable fiscal year-end projections for the ANESU Food Service Cooperative. There was discussion and acceptance of several ENDS monitoring reports, and the Board approved the hiring of a new professional staff member, Andrew Flood, who will be teaching in next year's 4-5-6 grade configuration.

Act 46 Update

The ANESU Act 46 Study Committee is now meeting weekly. The Board recognizes New Haven committee representatives Ed McGuire and Sarah LaPerle for their continued service. As previously announced, the Committee is recommending a Unified Union School District under a single Board and budget, similar to what has been adopted in our neighboring Supervisory Unions. The Committee is recommending that voting on the adoption should occur in each of the 5 towns in conjunction with Election Day on November 8th. The official Act 46 Study Report and proposed Articles of Agreement for the Unified Union are in their later stages of development. Expect accelerated communications and calls for community engagements in the next several weeks.
