Clerk News: The State Primary is the next election is on Tuesday, August 13, 2024. Polls are open in the New Haven Town Hall from 7:00 am - 7:00 pm. New Haven is now a split district, Addison-3 and Addison-5. Addison-3 will have different ballots than Addison-5, this is mainly due to electing different State Representatives for each district. Addison-3 is primarily the western side of town and Addison-5 is the eastern side. This is the second State Primary we have had since becoming a split district, please bear with us, we may ask for your address when you enter the polls and then direct you to the proper entrance checklist and ballot.

Absentee ballots are available now; please call or email to request an absentee ballot. Or you can go to the Secretary of States website, go to my voter page and log in to request a ballot be mailed to you.

WRAP Program: Want to weatherize your home but wondering how to pay for it? The Weatherization Repayment Assistance Program (WRAP) may be able to help you. WRAP is intended to assist both homeowners and renters in Vermont in pursuing energy-saving projects by allowing them to pay for the costs over time through a low-interest monthly charge on their utility bill.

WRAP can finance home weatherization projects like insulation and air sealing as well as heat pumps, electric water heaters, and advanced wood heating systems.

Vermont homeowners and renters interested in Weatherization Repayment Assistance Program (WRAP) should contact the Program Administrators at Vermont Gas Systems (802-863-4511), Burlington Electric Department (802-865-7300), or Efficiency Vermont (1-888-921-5990). They can help answer specific questions about whether your project may qualify for WRAP.
