**1. Appointments:**

- **MAUSD Board Rep:** Kathy Barrett made a motion to forward Patrick Lawrence's name to the MAUSD Board as the New Haven representative to the School Board for a 3-year term. Motion seconded by Taborri Bruhl. Vote by roll call 5 yes / 0 no
- **Conservation Commission:** Kathy Barrett made a motion to appoint Adam Rice and reappoint David Lewis to the Conservation Commission, both for 3-year terms. Motion seconded by Taborri Bruhl. Vote by roll call 5 yes / 0 no
- **Planning Commission:** Kathy Barrett made a motion to appoint Megan Ooms and Betsy Taylor and reappoint Benj Putnam to the Planning Commission, all for 3-year terms. Motion seconded by John Roleau. Vote by roll call 5 yes / 0 no

- **Town Hall / Beeman School water leak:** No change
- **Train Depot update given by Steve Dupoise:** Steve has a meeting tomorrow with several people about where to position the Depot. The northwest corner of the Sleeper lot has been declared a Class III wetland by the Feds. To avoid having the Army Corps of Engineers come and look at the site, we could potentially move the Depot approximately 16' north, just off the parking lot and keep it out of the wetlands. Right now, the only parties who have shown an interest in using the Depot are the Credit Union and the Historical Society.

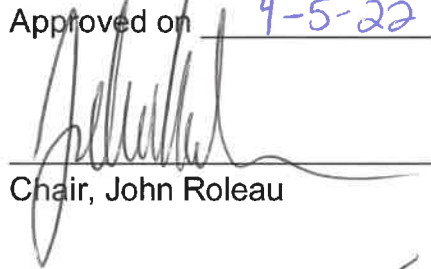

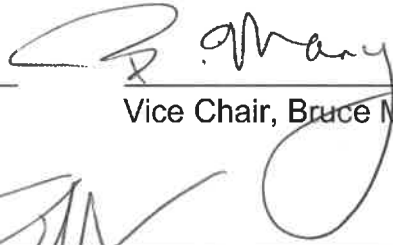

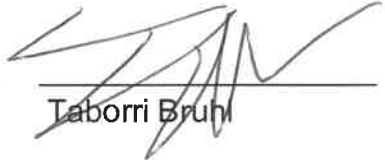
