ROADS

- Meet with State regarding intersection of Route 17 and East Street – State has identified the intersection of East Street and Route 17 as a safety project. Would like to eliminate the Y intersection and turn into a T intersection located in the middle of the Y. Cars coming from the East on 17 have limited visibility as they come over the crest of the hill. Many accidents when cars try to turn left onto East St. State would like to turn the project over to the Town to do and the State will pay for it. Old roadways would be removed, dug up and reseeded. CV will need to move a pole. Culvert will need to be moved / replaced. State would reimburse for all related costs. Administration, legal etc. Process is for the town to submit an estimate for the cost of the work. Then an agreement would be drawn up. AOT will do the signage.
- Meet with Dick Hosking – Roads annual meeting - review grant applications. – Discuss issues with culvert on South St. between Selby / Lyons Larger culvert still has problems at certain times due to amount of drainage from surrounding lands. Can't put in larger culvert. Discuss possibility of paving both sides of the road so water could flow over with out destroying the road. Would like inventory of culverts and roads. New ruling on wetlands / ditching along roadways. Likely to get funding on Beldon Falls Road project. Not sure about resurfacing on South St.
- Grader – Decide to lease a grader for 23,000.00 per year.

Discuss need for 3rd person on Road Crew. Will do interviews on April 4th at 6:30. Phil Busier will call the current applicants.

- Sign Over Wt Permits – signed
- Sign pay orders

VELCO – Would like to warn a resolution at the upcoming special meeting asking the town's people to authorize the selectboard to request that the Public Service Board follow the wishes of the town, by moving the sub station and maintaining the power lines in the existing corridor not moving closer to Forrest Drive.
