## SELECTBOARD REPORT

There was a lively discussion about the possibility of a Town Administrator at the last meeting. The board decided to form a committee to draft a job description, which will be reviewed when compiled. The Board is looking at combining the position of Zoning Administrator with an administrative position in hopes of getting a long term applicant. The Planning Commission had recommended creating a full time position for Zoning in hopes of recruiting a broader pool of applicants. As I mentioned previously, this is still an ongoing discussion over the next few meetings so please plan to attend. Some proposed Zoning changes were reviewed at a joint meeting of the Selectboard, Planning Commission and DRB .

## TOWN CLERK NEWS

Last Chance – if you haven't licensed your dog(s) yet, please do so now. I am required to submit a list of all unlicensed dogs to the Select board after the end of May per State Statute **20 V.S.A. §3590(b)**: "On receiving a list of dogs and wolf-hybrids from persons authorized by the legislative body, the municipal clerk shall notify the owners or keepers of all dogs and wolf-hybrids named on the list that have not already been licensed or inoculated, and after **May 30** shall furnish to the legislative body a list of dogs and wolf-hybrids not licensed or inoculated as required by law. Owners shall also be notified that unlicensed or uninoculated dogs or wolf-hybrids may be destroyed."

So please, avoid being on the list, and license **today**. Fee's are \$11.00 for spayed/neutered and \$17.00 for unspayed/unneutered dogs and they must have a current rabies certificate on file in the Town Office to be eligible for a new license. If your dogs current rabies certificate is on file, visit our towns website and pay by credit card, we will mail your license to you.

The Town Office will be closed May 2<sup>nd</sup> for training.

## GREEN UP DAY INSTRUCTIONS

Since the first Green Up Day was launched by Governor Deane Davis in 1970, thousands of Vermonters of all ages and backgrounds have come together on the **first Saturday in May** to pick up litter from roadsides, waterways, woods and public areas. We are looking forward to seeing familiar faces and new neighbors on the Town Green from **9 - 11am on Saturday May 4<sup>th</sup>** to pick up **FREE** Green Up Bags, gloves, and register the area you will Green Up on the Town Road Map.

Our Road Crew will **only** pick up the **BRIGHT GREEN** bags from each area on Monday, May 6<sup>th</sup>. **Please make sure to leave the bags where you left off, tied shut and placed just off the side of the road.** Any tires, batteries, large/awkward pieces that you find can be placed on the side of the road with your full Green Up bag. Please do not try to haul big or dangerous pieces out to the road-call the number below to report the location, or to report dumping sites, hazardous waste dumpsites or animal carcasses. **NO FURNITURE** will be picked up –if you haul it out of the woods, **YOU** must dispose of it.

The Health Department reminds everyone that tick season is upon us so please dress protectively for the occasion and check for ticks when you are done your work.

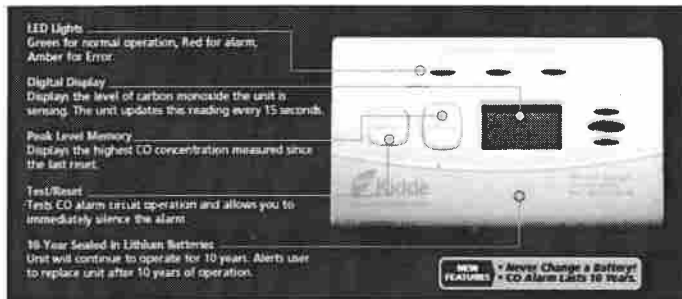
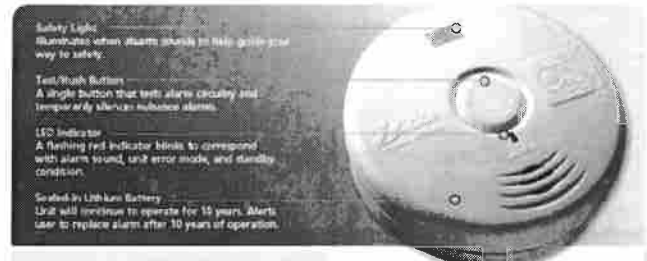
