## New Haven Town Lands Committee

Members of the public with an interest in Town-owned properties are invited to join the New Haven Town Lands Committee at its upcoming site visits and meetings.

The next site visit, scheduled for Saturday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, at 9:00 AM, will involve four properties on River Road: a Town cemetery and three smaller undeveloped parcels that the Town has acquired over the years. We will meet at the parking area at the corner of Munger Street and Cove Road in New Haven Mills, and then proceed "downstream" along River Road to visit the properties in the following order:

1. The "ACCT" property in New Haven Mills, adjacent to the New Haven River at the southeast corner of Munger Street and River Road.
2. The "O'Mara" property on the east side of River Road, just south of New Haven Mills.
3. The Riverside Cemetery property.
4. The "Summer" property on the north side of River Road, just southwest of the Nash Bridge and the Halpin Road intersection.

The Committee's next regular meeting will be on Thursday, July 20<sup>th</sup>, at 7:00 PM, at the New Haven Town Offices. We will be discussing the four properties listed above and will also work on making recommendations to the Selectboard regarding the use and management of DeMers Park, which was the subject of an earlier site visit.

## **New Haven wins VT Supreme Court case regarding the use of box trailers for storage**

The Town of New Haven recently received notice from the VT Supreme Court affirming and upholding the Environmental Court decision regarding a New Haven property. In part, the decision clearly concludes that when box trailers are un-road worthy (unregistered and uninspected) and stored on property, they are to be considered structures and therefore must comply with New Haven Zoning.
