We continue to work in the Town Hall building on the mold issue. We are hoping to have the mold cleared out by the time you read this newsletter. We have continued cleaning, removed some wallboard, and removed all the afterschool program equipment and any other material that may have been in contact with the mold. Another air quality test will be done on the 31st. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may have caused, but we've been trying our best to correct the situation. We do not want anyone using the Town Hall to become sick.

In the new town office building, the geo-thermal pumps have been replaced. The Selectboard has hired Harold Tricou to oversee the maintenance of the town buildings. We continue to monitor the Vermont Gas pipeline and weigh in on the proposed project through New Haven.

We will begin the budgeting process in December, so we will be looking for budgets from the various committees.

The Armchair Naturalist Speaker Series

White-Tailed Deer Biology, Ecology and Management

November 14, 2013 - 7:00 p.m. New Haven Town Offices

Presenter Adam Murkowski is currently the deer project leader for the Vermont Fish and Wildlife Department. Adam is a Wisconsin native and holds a Bachelor's degree in Wildlife Management from the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Points and a Master's degree in Forest Resources from the University of Arkansas-Monticello. Prior to coming to Vermont, Adam was involved with deer research activities in Wisconsin, Colorado, Arkansas, and North Carolina. Adam currently resides in Rutland and enjoys hunting, fishing, and other outdoor activities.

Hunters: The Vermont Fish and Wildlife Department has embarked upon a comprehensive deer management evaluation. This evaluation of current and potential season structures and harvest regulations may result in changes to Vermont's current deer hunting seasons and regulations. Adam will give a presentation discussing the evaluation and potential management alternatives. This meeting will be an opportunity to hear about the comprehensive evaluation process, proposed alternative management options, and provide the public with the opportunity to ask questions.
