Selectboard News:

I hope this newsletter finds you all well and you have had a chance to enjoy some fall activities. Speaking of which, Halloween in the park has commenced and is looking fantastic! Thank you to all the volunteers who have made the decorations and displays this year, it really looks great! My children have been peeking through the window admiring it and my Australian Cattle dog has been barking at the Skeletons swaying in the breeze!!

We had an update on the moving of the Railroad depot last week. The building is getting some demo on the interior, the chimneys will be removed down to the roof line and steel beams will be put through the basement for moving. The move date has been rescheduled to the end of January.

Line striping has been done for our town funded roads, however the state has sent an email that all class 2 roads are behind schedule and there is a national shortage on yellow paint, so unfortunately we won't be getting yellow lines on our class two roads this year due to COVID delays.

The top coat paving will be happening soon for the covering of the Town Hill Road culverts. We appreciate your patience in this repair as it will come out way better next year when the final paving is complete. We would like the cross culverts and large sunken section of road and a winter of frost to settle before we do a final top coat. This will help the sections settle for a permanent repair. Believe it or not there is a method to the madness.

We had our first deep frost this weekend and I expect snow to not be far behind so now is the time to start switching over snow tires and putting your plows on, it may not be heavy but it's coming. Hope everyone has a great Halloween and be safe!

There are no elections in Vermont this November; the next election will be for Town Meeting in March 2022. Something new added to the Town Meeting ballot will be voting on whether to or not to have Lincoln Elementary School leave the MAUSD District. I'm sure you have all read about it in the local paper or seen postings on Front Porch Forum.

Another note about Town Meeting: The Selectboard is considering putting the funding of non-profit agencies into the General Fund budget rather than in separate articles. This would only apply to those non-profits who have petitioned and have been approved for 5 consecutive years. The reason for considering this is to streamline our ballots. We currently vote on 23 separate articles for non-profit agencies. Let the Selectboard know your thoughts on this.
